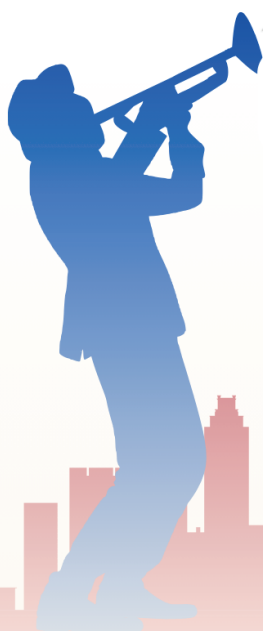

Eddy Robinson, Conductor & Music Director



In March of 2021, Bend Pops Orchestra was privileged to announce Eddy Robinson as its new conductor. With the ebbs and flows of the pandemic, Eddy was unable to take up the baton until the spring of 2022, and the orchestra could not perform in concert that season. The Holiday Concert in 2022 marked Eddy's public performance debut with the Pops.

Bend Pops musicians have flourished under Eddy's leadership. He manages with grace and humor the challenges of a community group with all levels of ability, and his skills as a music educator have brought new passion and cohesion to the group. This

new synergy manifests itself in the group's improved sound and member enthusiasm.

Eddy is a wonderful musician in his own right and plays string bass with the Central Oregon Symphony. Eddy is in his 20th year of teaching orchestra in public schools, and his 13th year in Bend.

Gary Ruppert, Guest Performer



Gary is a classical and jazz pianist, and has been a performer and educator in Oregon for almost 50 years. His entire career has been centered around helping audiences better understand and appreciate what they are listening to, no matter what style that may be. He retired from Linn-Benton Community College, having served as a music faculty member, Chair of Performing Arts, and Dean of Liberal Arts, in addition to being a past president of Oregon Music Teachers' Association and original author of their jazz piano syllabus. This multifaceted background has given Gary a comprehensive grasp of education and the

need for broad-based understanding of all the arts.

Gary will be performing "The West Side", his own arrangement of music by Leonard Bernstein.
