Eddy Robinson is an orchestra conductor, music educator, and performing musician known for bringing energy, warmth, and joy to the podium. A graduate of the University of Oregon (B.M.Ed., 2004), he teaches middle and high school musicians. He has conducted the Bend Pops Orchestra since 2021, where he has been a fundamental factor in more than doubling the ensemble's size. During his tenure at Mountain View High School, his orchestras have

grown in both size and artistic quality, qualifying for and competing in the OSAA Orchestra State Championships multiple times. Eddy also serves as Principal Bass of the Central Oregon Symphony, maintaining an active performance career alongside his teaching and conducting.

Dr. Jennifer Stevenson, Composer of “Return to Joy”

Dr. Jennifer Stevenson is a Scotland-based composer, clarinetist, and educator whose works have been commissioned by numerous organizations, including the Central Oregon Symphony, the Cascade Horizon Band, Whistling Hens, the Cedar Valley Chamber Music Festival, the LA Musical Salon, and private artists around the world. Her compositions have been performed internationally, and her piece for soprano and clarinet won 1st place in the 2021 Darkwater Festival Composition Competition and received Grammy® consideration for Best Contemporary Classical Composition in 2023. A recipient of multiple grants from Meet the Composer and the American Composers Forum, Jennifer holds degrees from DePaul University, Rice University, and the University of Southern California, where she also taught music and counseling courses. We are delighted to welcome her today for the premiere of “Return to Joy”, written especially for the Bend Pops Orchestra.


